All Saints Day

The cult of the Saints began around the 3rd century, and flourished from the 4th to 6th centuries. The feast of All Saints was instituted by Pope Boniface IV in 609 AD. Pope Saint John Paul II canonized more saints during his pontificate than any of his predecessors (482) until Pope Francis, who has canonized 885, as of this writing. Many canonized saints have their own distinct place in the Roman Missal and the liturgical calendar, as do those whose “causes” are still in process for canonization but not quite there yet. This holy day of obligation celebrates even those who are not official saints of the Church yet are known to have lived holy lives by the people who knew them. – Elaine Rendler-McQueeney
