ASH WEDNESDAY

This is the day we go to church clean and come home dirty. Instead of fasting and doing penance in private, today we proclaim our penance to the world. "Did you get your ashes?" people will ask. It may be better to ask "Did you mean your ashes?" The ashes we receive today, the dies cinerum (day of ashes), are the result of burning blessed palm fronds from the previous year's Palm Sunday. Our practice of receiving these ashes probably began in the eighth century. The distribution of ashes was formally instituted by Pope Urban II at the Synod of Benevento in 1091.
