The monetary donations to the I-35 and Martensdale/St. Marys Schools are utilized at the schools' discretion to aid students who need help with expenses such as school lunch tickets, winter coats, hats and gloves, gym shoes and graduation caps and gowns.

MWEA is a nonprofit organization consisting of churches located in the Madison and Warren Counties in or near the Interstate-35 and Martensdale/St. Marys School Districts. In addition to their donations to the two schools and other entities named above, MWEA has some ability to assist transient travelers in need of gasoline or food money.
